

ELIZABETH STREET ROADWORKS

INFORMATION SHEET | OCTOBER 2020

From Monday 26 October to Thursday 19 November, works to construct a new hospital road connecting Burnside Drive and Elizabeth Street will see temporary closure of the eastern end of Elizabeth Street.

These works will impact both pedestrian and vehicle access to Entrance E, F and G, specifically Renal Isolation Dialysis and Transit Lounge.

Vehicle access to the Entrance G car park will be via Burnside Drive only, with a temporary route in place through the construction zone, managed with traffic control. Patient transport and emergency vehicles will be prioritised.

External pedestrian access from Entrance J to Entrance G and F will be maintained, with pedestrian access to Entrance E via the existing access ramp on Elizabeth Street (no access to pedestrian crossing).

Note: Future works will see the temporary closure of Burnside Drive and the eastern campus access bridge for a period of five days in late November. Further details and alternate access information will be circulated in the lead up to these works.

SUMMARY OF IMPACTS 26 OCT TO 19 NOV

- Eastern end of Elizabeth Street closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic
- No vehicular access to Entrance G car park from Elizabeth Street
- No pedestrian access to Entrance F, G or J from Elizabeth Street
- Pedestrian link between Entrance J and Entrance G and F to be maintained
- Pedestrian access to Entrance E will be via the existing ramp
