Health Infrastructure

It is an exciting time for the local community with the NSW Government investing \$790 million for the redevelopment of Liverpool Hospital.

As one of the state's biggest infrastructure projects, the precinct will boost the local economy and showcase Liverpool Hospital to the world as a hub for innovation and medical research.

The precinct will transform the experience of patients, staff and the community through high-quality personalised care, state-of-the art equipment and purposebuilt facilities. It will celebrate the region's vibrant multicultural community through the integration of arts and culture.





How will Liverpool benefit from the redevelopment?

The redevelopment will provide enhanced healthcare and services for the community, close to home. This increased capacity will be complemented by expanded clinical services, public spaces and car parking, and integrated with research and teaching facilities to help ensure that Liverpool Hospital meets the needs of the growing community.

The employment opportunities generated through the redevelopment will boost the local economy, both during construction and on completion, and our staff will have the opportunity to work in a contemporary facility that supports their ongoing development.

What will the new Liverpool Health and Academic Precinct include?

- Larger emergency department and more theatres
- Expanded neonatal intensive care unit and children's services
- Enhanced maternity and women's health services
- Integrated cancer services
- Increased ambulatory care services and outpatient clinics
- New multi-storey car park with improved pick-up and drop-off points.

Will patient care be impacted during construction?

Patients will experience no reduction in the high quality of care provided by Liverpool Hospital. Disruptions will be minimised and those affected will be informed of any planned changes.

Will there be enough parking?

The new Liverpool Hospital multi-storey car park, which opened in 2022, provides an additional 500 spaces on campus. There are dedicated parking areas for staff and visitors and more drop-off and pick-up points.

When will the redevelopment be completed?

The new building will be delivered in two stages, as well as refurbishments occurring throughout the project.

Construction of Stage 1 will be completed in 2024. Construction of Stage 2 is expected to be completed in 2027. A program of refurbishment works within existing buildings are occurring progressively during the project duration.
